REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Unfavourable spring weather was also a factor in revenues and transactions for the month of April with all regions except Ontario posting lower dollar volumes over April 2021. Most clubs in the Prairies and Quebec were unable to open at all during the month due to lingering winter conditions. Elsewhere there was some limited play, but it was far from a robust month. Likewise, transaction numbers fell from prior years.

Despite the April revenue declines, the YTD dollar volumes remain slightly ahead of 2021 (+2.1%) while transaction numbers are off considerably (–15%) from the first 4 months of 2021.
