REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Nationally, the YTD Revenue results remain more than 20% above the prior year, with double-digit growth seen in all regions of the country. Both Atlantic Canada and British Columbia are showing strong YTD growth of more than 30% followed by the Prairies and Quebec at more than 20%. This is mainly due to early season increases in Rounds Played and the re-opening of Atlantic accommodations.

YTD transaction numbers remain 12.5% ahead of 2020 levels.
