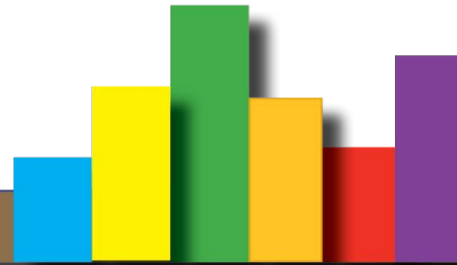

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Wet weather continued to impact play in most regions of the country in June. The Quebec and Atlantic regions showed strong increases over June 2023, with the Atlantic region achieving a notable 9.9% rise. Both the Prairies and British Columbia experienced declines in June of 9.4% and 6.7% respectively. Ontario and Alberta were essentially unchanged over the same period last year.

National YTD numbers remain positive, with a nearly 2% increase over the previous year. Additionally, rounds played in all regions continue to exceed 5-year averages, with a 3.4% increase for June and an impressive 16.5% increase YTD. These figures highlight the resilience and ongoing interest in golf across Canada despite the challenging weather conditions.
