Highlights

- For the third consecutive month, rounds played nationally increased slightly over 2023 and are now up 4.8% year-to-date.
- Atlantic Canada continued its strong season, led by an exceptional performance in New Brunswick, where September rounds surpassed the national average by 12%. This marks the first time in five years that the Atlantic Canada region exceeded the national average rounds played in September.
- Québec saw a modest growth of 1.8%, driven by numbers in the Eastern Townships region. Rounds played were up 46.8% year-over-year, surpassing the national average by 24%.
