REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

YTD rounds played in all regions continue to be significantly ahead of the record-setting 2020 levels of play with Quebec (+31.6%) and the Atlantic region (+18.6%) leading the way in growth over the prior year. Nationally YTD rounds are up 13.8% despite the small decreases seen in most of the country for the month of August.

Quebec was the only region in the month of August to see an increase over August 2020 showing a 14.0% growth in rounds played for the month. Weather conditions (wildfires/smoke) in British Columbia were a major factor affecting that region while changing COVID circumstances affected the entire western half of the country. Ontario saw a slight drop in rounds with exceptionally hot weather throughout the month contributing to the decrease while Atlantic Canada can mostly be described as flat.
