REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

While both Alberta (+4.1%) and the Prairies (+11.1%) saw modest gains for the month of August; the remainder of the country were lower than 2021 levels resulting in a slight drop in National Average Rounds in August (-2.6%).

When comparing rounds to weather, operator scores from across the country were generally favourable (7.1 or higher) indicating a modest retreat from the very high COVID demand/utilization levels.

Although the small August decline brings the National YTD result to a decrease of 6.3%, that level is still 11% higher than the 5-year average and represents a gain of almost 2,000 rounds per course.
