## REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Although July rounds fell short of 2021 levels in all regions of the country, each region exceeded the July 5 -year average leading to an $8.9 \%$ growth nationally. The Atlantic, Quebec, and Prairie regions showed the largest increases compared to the July 5 -year average.

YTD play is down $7.5 \%$ from 2021, however it remains almost $12 \%$ better than the 5 -year average which equates to an average gain of just over 1,500 rounds per course for the 2022 season to date.
