REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

The exceptional level of play reached in 2020 has continued and even increased slightly in the current season. Nationally, Rounds Played for July increased slightly from 2020. Quebec saw modest increases in rounds for July at 9% while the western half of the country saw slight growth of between 2-4%. Ontario's slight decline is likely a result of unusually wet weather in some parts of the province.

The National YTD increase in rounds is 20% most likely due to earlier openings that came with favourable spring and early summer weather.
