## REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Nationally, Rounds Played for June were up slightly from 2020 with some modest increases in the Alberta and Atlantic regions. The national average for June is more than $22 \%$ higher than the 5 -year average, while the season to date is $29 \%$ ahead of the 5 -year average level.

YTD increase over 2020 is substantial with a $32 \%$ increase reflecting earlier openings compared to 2020 , favourable spring and early summer weather, and the absence of COVID closures early in the year with the exception of the temporary closure in Ontario.

The surge in play that occurred in 2020 is continuing for the current season.
