REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

June rounds were down in all regions across the country when compared to June 2021. With weather rating near normal in most regions, it would appear that the COVID surge of the past two years may be ebbing somewhat.

Although the National YTD results are 8.8% below 2021 levels, that still represents a 12% gain over the 5-year average. This National 5-year YTD growth is mainly driven by the effect of the May 2021 Ontario COVID closure period along with strong increases in Quebec and Atlantic regions.

All regions across the country are showing 5-year YTD average gains save the Prairies. Very difficult weather in many parts of that region has been the dominant theme so far this season.
