## **REPORT HIGHLIGHTS**

NGCOA Canada Rounds Played Report for October continued at record pace although down 1.9% when comparing to October 2020, but still more than 45% higher than 5-year average levels for the month. The better late season weather in Alberta and Prairies contributed to their double digit increases over October 2020 while Quebec was virtually unchanged from the prior year. British Columbia, Ontario, and Atlantic regions posted lower rounds totals than a year ago, with much of British Columbia experiencing below average weather conditions.

Nationally year-to-date (YTD) average rounds remained at unprecedented levels; up a further 9% from the record-breaking 2020 season and 24.1% better than the 5-year average. This growth was evident across the country where YTD numbers for all regions increased with Quebec leading the way with more than 22% growth.
