Despite generally favorable weather in British Columbia and from Ontario east, Alberta and the Prairie regions experienced multiple closures due to adverse weather conditions. Wet weather in Quebec and the rest of Ontario also contributed to significant closures. These challenges impacted rounds played and revenue results for the month, both of which showed a decline compared to 2023. The variability in weather across regions highlights the seasonal unpredictability and its effect on overall performance.
