July saw an improvement in weather conditions compared to June, leading to fewer closures and slightly better conditions than last July in many regions. Notably, British Columbia and Alberta exceeded their five-year weather averages, offering some positive momentum.

Year-to-date (YTD), weather scores remain below average from Ontario westward, indicating ongoing challenges. Conversely, Quebec and the Atlantic provinces have experienced slightly better-than-average conditions (through the end of July), supporting golf operations in those areas.
