In June 2024, wet weather significantly impacted golf operations, particularly in the Prairies and Alberta, resulting in higher year-to-date closures than in other regions. Western provinces experienced almost two weeks of lost play in just three months, while central Canada faced approximately a week and a half of closures. Ontario saw a mix of weather conditions that impacted golf operations differently across the region. While the overall weather score for Ontario was 6.1, indicating relatively average conditions, some areas experienced significant wet weather events. Quebec reported a weather score of 6.9, indicating relatively better conditions, while the Atlantic region enjoyed the best weather, with the lowest number of closures and a weather score of 7.
