Highlights

- Ontario and Quebec experienced unseasonably poor weather in May, with Ontario posting its lowest May weather score since 2019 and Quebec recording its lowest May since tracking began in 2015.
- Alberta led the country, achieving a May weather score above 7 for only the second time in the
 past six years.
- Wildfires in the Prairies dominated extreme weather headlines in May. However, their impact on playable weather was limited, as Manitoba and Saskatchewan averaged just three closures during the month and recorded an above-average weather score.
